We still need to turn to our Father

4TH SUNDAY OF LENT

Last October forecasts were predicting higher pork prices in the spring and summer, based on a larger trend with some trepidation. They saw the greater than average weekly slaughter as a sign of some herd liquidation, a result attributed to the higher feed prices brought about by last summer's drought. With pork producers unwilling to foot the bill for the increased cost of feeding, there was a surge in animals brought to market. While consumers realized an initial benefit with lower prices in the fall and winter, the lack of feeder animals in the production pipeline means higher prices at the grocery store this spring. The Easter ham may be a little more expensive this year.

This weekend's Gospel is so familiar that most of us could probably relay the events the parable recounts by heart. The younger son ends up hiring himself out to a hog farmer, a particularly despicable trade in the cultural context of Jesus' time, since swine were considered unclean according to Jewish law. In his suffering the young man longed to eat the food that he was feeding to the pigs. He finally came to his senses, realizing that he needed to change his life. His profligate spending and former life of excess had brought him to a low point from which he needed to recover.

The economic situation of the past few years might serve as a reminder to all of us that life is more than a healthy bank account. A year ago spring, it looked like farmers would have a bumper crop. Then the drought came, affecting food prices and a lot more. Even when we think we have it all, we are still dependent. In the Gospel, the younger son turned back to his father in his need. The older son needed to turn back to his father because he had forgotten that he was always there.

Qué triste es para los padres cuando sus hijos les piden la herencia mucho antes de que ellos mueran. Casi siempre los padres responden a sus hijos como el padre de la parábola de hoy le responde a su hijo mayor: "Hijo, tú siempre estás conmigo y todo lo mío es tuyo". En el Evangelio de hoy, el hijo menor demanda su herencia, mientras que el mayor escucha sin decir palabra. Su protesta viene después, al regreso de su hermano cuando éste le pide perdón a su padre.

Ambos hijos buscaban un arreglo atractivo con un sentido oficial de recibir algo. Ellos calcularon lo que podían recibir y querían estar seguros que lo recibirían. Como vemos, la familia no era pobre: el padre tenía todo para ellos. Sin embargo, ambos hijos se quejaron de lo que no recibieron. ¿Somos nosotros así? ¿Cobramos a Dios lo que nos da? A lo mejor sí, o a lo mejor no. Pero sí debemos de estar seguros de hacer lo opuesto de estos hijos. El agradecimiento, el saber dar las gracias, es un don que no todos lo desarrollamos en nuestra vida. San Pablo nos lo muestra de una forma diferente: el agradecimiento es una nueva creación de la persona que se abre a Cristo y agradece. Ésta es la herencia nueva para todos nosotros. Dios nos la ofrece, la aceptemos o no. Éste es nuestro reto como cristianos. Los dones de la gracia y la compasión de Dios saben esperar el momento preciso para que cada uno de nosotros nos transformemos en el amor que siempre nos ofrece el Señor.
