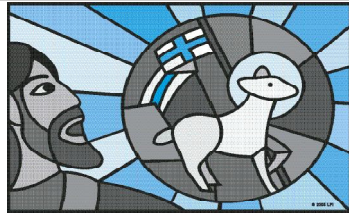

least. John the Baptist's underlying message, however, would have been crystal clear to the audience who heard it. The Jews were used to the idea of sacrificing a lamb in a ritual of atonement. Now, John was declaring that this man walking towards him, Jesus, was in fact the new lamb, the sacrificial offering that would atone for the sins not just of one person, but of all people. The sins of the whole world are forgiven in Christ.

The whole world, of course, means everybody. No one is excluded from the gift of salvation. Sadly, not all people accept the gift, but it is available to them nonetheless. Today we might ask ourselves where we stand on this spectrum. Do we believe that Jesus' death has saved us? Do we believe that our sins are washed away through the sacrifice of this most spotless victim? To take it a step further, do we accept that God can forgive even the sins of our enemies, of those who have hurt and mistreated us? Can we forgive them too, as God has done through his Son, or do we fall short in this regard?



When we struggle to forgive someone, we can pray for the grace to love that person as Jesus has loved us. Today, may we put to death our grudges and resentments in imitation of the Lamb who sacrificed his life on our behalf.

**2º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO**

Ha llegado el tiempo de hacer camino con Jesús, ya que el tiempo litúrgico de la Navidad ha terminado y empezamos hoy los domingos del tiempo ordinario. El Evangelio de hoy es continuación del domingo pasado, cuando Mateo nos recordaba la escena del Bautismo del Señor. El día de hoy, Juan Bautista da testimonio de Jesús. Este Evangelio es el inicio de la narración de los hechos y palabras del Señor Jesús, las cuales forman una gran parte del contenido del tiempo ordinario. El caminar junto con Jesús en su ministerio público nos da una gran oportunidad para nuestra conversión y para nuestro discipulado: ser llamados para luego ser enviados. "Ahora habla el Señor, el que me formó desde el seno materno, para que fuera su servidor" (Is 49, 5).

Nuestra tarea ahora es conocer a Cristo. Juan Bautista no lo conocía, pero una vez que le vio y descubrió que era el Mesías, inmediatamente dio testimonio de él: "Este es el Cordero de Dios, el que quita el pecado del mundo" (Jn 1, 29). ¿Qué tanto lo conozco yo? ¿La Eucaristía de cada domingo me ayuda a conocerlo cada vez más? Este año 2014, escucharemos las lecturas del Ciclo A basadas en el Evangelio según San Mateo.
