6TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

“But I say to you, whoever is angry with his brother will be liable to judgment.” In today’s Gospel, Jesus takes the Ten Commandments to a deeper level. Instead of focusing merely on external actions, like murder or adultery, Jesus wants us to examine what is in our hearts, like anger or lust. These internal dispositions are the root cause of the outward sins. Jesus is teaching us to take responsibility for our attitudes as well as our actions.

Some may say that we cannot control our internal thoughts and feelings, or that it’s unrealistic to expect us to eliminate anger and lust from our inner selves. But, as Saint Thérèse of Lisieux put it, Christ would not command the impossible. So it must be possible to purify our hearts and control our thoughts. But we don’t have to do this on our own power. Jesus expects great things of us, but he doesn’t expect us to do them alone! Through the presence of his Spirit in our hearts, we have divine assistance to accomplish this task.

When we pray to God for the gift of the Holy Spirit, he responds by filling our hearts with the gifts and fruits of the Holy Spirit-wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, fear of the Lord, love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, and chastity. When these wonderful things are present within us, the bad things have nowhere to settle. Thus we can be transformed into people who don’t just live the commandments, but who love them as well.

 Cuando yo preparaba niños para su primera Comunión y enseñaba la sesión de catequesis referente a los mandamientos, les decía que había que guardar los mandamientos. Una vez, un niño me dijo que él no tenía lugar para guardarlos. Yo me quedé sin habla, porque en su respuesta él me enseñaba que muchos de los que nos decimos cristianos no entendemos lo que significa guardar los mandamientos. Igualmente, me enseñó que realmente los mandamientos ocupan un espacio en nuestro corazón. ¿Qué creemos nosotros? ¿Tenemos lugar para guardar los mandamientos?

Podemos entender los mandamientos solo si los comprendemos dentro del pacto que Dios ha hecho con su pueblo, concretamente sellado en Jesucristo. Éstos son también un don de Dios, concedido a los que hacen esa alianza con Dios mismo. Los mandamientos no ayudan a mantener fidelidad a Dios en lo profundo del corazón. Pero lo más importante es la implicación hecha en nuestro bautismo. Los mandamientos son para mantener una amistad profunda con Dios, no para alejarnos de ésta. Hombres y mujeres estamos llamados a vivir en comunión: los mandamientos nos transforman en criaturas nuevas a imagen de Jesucristo. Guardar los mandamientos es una opción libre que corresponde al amor gratuito de Dios. Para descubrir ese amor gratuito de Dios hay que descubrir a Jesucristo. ¡Sin Jesús, no llegaremos al Padre! Dios quiere corazones rectos y sinceros. Solo Dios nos renueva y purifica. El guardar los mandamientos nos ayuda a ello.
