7TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

“Give to the one who asks of you, and do not turn your back on one who wants to borrow.” At first glance, we might think this instruction refers only to money or possessions. Jesus would surely want us to be generous with our finances, and in the spirit of today’s Gospel, to give without seeking to receive. However, the principle also applies to our time and our talents.

Most likely, some of the people God has placed in our lives are “asking” for our time: children in need of care; elderly parents; neighbors or friends experiencing sickness, etcetera. Often, the needs of others do not coincide perfectly with our own plans. Rather, serving our families and communities frequently requires a change in our normal program of life. When such interruptions occur, do we share our time and attention freely, handing over our “cloak” as well without a grumble or a grudge?

And what about the use of our God-given talents? We have all been blessed in different ways with gifts that can strengthen our communities. When our abilities could be useful to others, are we willing to share them without seeking recompense? Gifts of organization or artistry, culinary or mechanical skills, musical or ministerial talents...what we have received can be a blessing to those in our parish, our workplace, our neighborhood, and our family. Rather than being stingy with the treasures God has given us, may we be willing to follow the Lord’s command to go the extra mile.

7º DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

A pesar de las enseñanzas de Jesús, hace ya más de 2000 años, y seguimos con la ley de ojo por ojo y diente por diente. Parece como si Cristo no hubiera dicho nada sobre este tema. Las palabras que Dios dio a Moisés en la primera lectura son una melodía armoniosa para nuestros oídos, pero parecen solo llegar hasta ahí. No penetran en nuestro corazón: “Sean santos, porque yo, el Señor, soy santo” (Lv 19, 2). Cuando escuchamos hablar de santidad, esta invitación nos parece muy remota y lejana, y pensamos mejor en el padrecito o la monjita. No pensamos en que esta idea le concierne al cristiano común y corriente. Pero, ¿cómo se llega a esa meta? ¿Cómo se hace uno santo?

Para ser santo lo primero que se requiere es esfuerzo y autodisciplina. No existe un atajo hacia el camino del cielo. La oración, la justicia, la paz y el amor son los ingredientes de la santidad. No está en lo exterior, sino en la liberación del Espíritu que habita dentro de cada uno de nosotros. San Pablo nos lo dice en la segunda lectura: “¿No saben ustedes que son el templo de Dios y que el Espíritu de Dios habita en ustedes?” (1 Cor 3, 16). La santidad es dejar brillar esa luz sobre la cual Jesús nos ha hablado tanto en los domingos anteriores. La santidad es pretender cada día esfuerzos nuevos para ser mejores. La santidad es vivir en el amor. El Evangelio de hoy termina con la siguiente frase: “Ustedes, pues, sean perfectos, como su Padre celestial es perfecto” (Mt 5, 48). No hay que frustrarnos. ¡Vivamos el amor lo mejor que podamos!
