IN ORDINARY TIME**

"It is as if a man were to scatter seed on the land and would sleep and rise night and day and through it all the seed would sprout and grow, he knows not how." In today's parable about the kingdom of God, Jesus gives us the image of something that grows "of its own accord." Yes, the man does the initial planting of the seed, but the real miracle of the seed turning into a full-grown plant happens without the intervention of the farmer. God makes it happen.

So too, with the kingdom of God, we are called to participate to a certain extent, but also to allow God to work. We first do our part when we "scatter seed" of faith, by living out the baptism that made us children of this glorious kingdom. 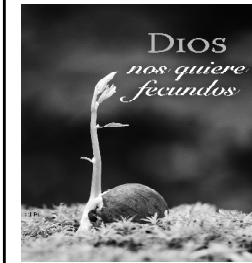
BLOOD DRIVE

11° DOMINGO DEL TIEMPO ORDINARIO

El mensaje del Evangelio de hoy está centrado claramente en dos parábolas referentes a la semilla y su crecimiento. La palabra de Dios siempre nos conduce a consecuencias de tipo moral, es decir el ver cómo actuamos y cómo nos comportamos. Y además de cómo comprender la perspectiva de Dios en su enseñanza; es decir cómo ver e interpretar la presencia de Dios en nuestra vida. El hecho es que la semilla crece sin saber cómo. Ésta tiene dentro de sí una fuerza y dinamismo que la hace germinar, brotar, crecer y madurar hasta morir. ¿Te dice algo esta enseñanza? ¿Qué relación tiene esta parábola con nuestra vida?

Analizando, en la vida humana existe una fuerza interior que lo mueve a amar, a ilusionarse a cumplir sueños y metas. Y mejor aún si el ser humano es movido por el amor de Dios, por el Espíritu interior por la gracia de los sacramentos, es cuando el reino de Dios crece notablemente. Pero, veamos, la parábola nos dirige a una virtud que debemos de practicar constantemente. La paciencia, la semilla tiene su ritmo, su proceso de maduración. Me imagino, que en tiempos de Jesús habría algunas personas que deseaban ver frutos inmediatos, sobretodo con lo relacionado a cambios en gobernantes, ayuda para los pobres y los enfermos. Era una tentación que Jesús contrasta con la comparación de la semilla. La vida tiene su proceso y no hay que quemar etapas. Muchas veces proyectos a corto plazo nos llevan al fracaso. En resumen, el mensaje de hoy es "Dios nos quiere fecundos dando fruto constante".
